Award Details: Winners will receive a shield engraved with their name and a certificate indicating their award category.

Eligibility Criteria:

Nationality: Indian

Employment Status: Open to University/College Professors, School/College Principals, Researchers, Registered Ph.D. Scholars, Social Workers, Scouts & Guides, NSS, NCC, YRC Coordinators, and Physical Education Trainers.

Age Limit:

For Young Faculty and Young Scientist Awards: Maximum age of 40 years as of December 31, 2024.

No age limit for other awards.

Membership Requirement: Award recipients must be members of the GRABS Educational Charitable Trust for the duration of the award program. The annual membership fee is Rs. 3000, but prior membership is not required for applicants.

Award Categories:

Best Faculty Award:

Eligibility: Teachers/Professors with a minimum of 10 years of teaching experience.

Best Young Faculty/Scientist/Social Scientist Award:

Eligibility: Professors with at least 4 years of teaching experience.

Best Researcher/Scientist/Social Scientist Award:

Eligibility: Professors/Researchers with a minimum of 8 years of teaching/research experience and at least 5 publications in refereed journals.

Best Young Researcher Award:

Eligibility: Registered Ph.D. candidates with at least 4 publications in refereed journals.

Best Research Supervisor Award:

Eligibility: Minimum 10 years of teaching/research experience, at least 8 publications, and supervision of more than 5 Ph.D. students.

Social Worker Award:

Eligibility: Significant contributions to the upliftment of marginalized communities.

Outstanding Service Award/Achievement Award for Excellence in Education:

Eligibility: Principals/Directors/Deans/Registrars at Colleges/Universities.

Special Lecture:

A one-day seminar on “**Good Academic Research Practices**” will precede the GRABS Awards ceremony.
